- 4. 23 November 1944.
 - a. Form 41-B Remarks.
 - (1) Form 41-B for 23 Nov 44 shows pilots remarks, "Interference from ART-13 on interphone" Captain Loeffler.
 - (2) Shows in remarks, two (2) red diagonals with no explanation.
 - b. Form 1-A Remarks.
 - (1) Form 1-A for 23 Nov 44 shows same remark as above; also radio preflight Put lead in antenna on compass.

 (Liaison key interferes with interphone) 23 Nov 44 Kedulich.
- 5. 24 November 1944.
 - a. Form 1-A Remarks.
 - (1) Form 1-A for 24 Nov 44 shows red diagonal by Vaccarelli.

(2) Airplane status today carries red diagonal and remark

- "Liaison heard on all positions of jack box."

 (3) In remarks, Pilots and Mechanics: #Liaison radio rec. and transmission comes in over interphone Left scanner unable to xmitt on VHF position when using it for emergency interphone.
- (4) Cross talk AN/ART-13 times badly.
- (5) 08-15-3 not correct Signed, C. H. Payne, 1st Lt., A.C.
- b. Porm 41-B Remarks.
 - (1) Form 41-B for 24 Nov 44 shows two (2) red diagonals carried no remarks in column 47 with reference to remarks in Form 1-A.

 - (1) Does not show status symbol for communications in Aux. Equip.
 - (2) Status today column shows red diag. and remark "Liaison Receiver and transmission comes in over interphone."
 - (3) Pilots and mechanics remarks column shows, "Left scanner unable to mix on VHF position when using it for emergency interphone."
 - b. Form 41-B Remarks.
 - (1) Shows two (2) red diagonals but no remarks as per form 1-4.

- 7. 26 November 1944.
 - a. Form 1-A Remarks.
 - (1) Shows red diagonal by Johnson in aux. equip. column.
 - (2) Airplane status today column shows, Lisison receivertransmitter comes in on interphone jack box.
 - (3) Remarks Pilots and mechanics shows, Radar needs lined up after installation Kennedy.
 - b. Not dated for 26 November 1944.
 - (1) Shows two (2) diagonals in column 15 for Communications and one (1) in column thirteen (13) for radar.

General Findings: Nothing done to clear interphone trouble. This trouble appears to have occurred after compliance of T.O. 03-40BC-2 - Water-proofing and Drainage of Interphone and Filter Boxes.
